CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Institution** and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitates effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry by acting as ambassadors to promote the industry.

SCOPE OF THE MoU

2.1. The **budding** graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

2.3. 2.6. Guest Lectures : Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

2.7. Faculty Development Programs: Second Party to training the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the Industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sectors, if available.

2.8. Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and can be provided/ recommended for the process on the company feasibility to the students. The Second Party will itself absorb as many candidates as possible from the trained students every year as per the requirement.

2.9. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the programmes on the terms specified herein.

2.10. There is no financial commitment on the part of the First Party i.e S.G.Govt. Degree College, PILER, The First Party to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately. The MoU is initially for a period of 5 years and will be extended for another period of 5 years based on mutual understanding and in any event if the both parties disagree to extend / terminate the MoU.it will be with mutual consent without any legal issues.

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estopped otherwise , create in either Party any right , title , interest or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how , inventions , patents , copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

VALIDITY

4.1. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either party on mutually agreed terms, during which period HAVIS MULTIMEDIA EDUCATION, TIRUPATI, Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU.

4.2. Bothe Parties may terminals this MoU upon 30 Calender days notice in writing in the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MoU as independents contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party shall have, not represent itself as having any authority under the terms f this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to external credit on behalf of the other Party.
