### A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

Sanjay Gandhi Govt. Degree College, Piler, Chittoor (Dt.) is striving to reach greater realm in the field of Higher Education ever since its inception i.e. 1980. The untiring efforts of Moghul Shaifullah Baig, the then Honorable Chairman, Rayalaseema Planning and Development Committee and a host of prominent local citizens of Piler town resulted in starting the college under the aegis of the Government of Andhra Pradesh. The college was inaugurated by Late Honorable Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Dr. M. Chenna Reddy, on the campus of Govt. Junior College, Piler on 22-08-1980. The new buildings were inaugurated by Sri. B. Gopala Krishna Reddy, the erstwhile Minister of Roads and Buildings on 26-06-1999 and consequently the college was shifted from Govt. Junior College campus to new campus which is 2 K.M. away from Piler town.

This college has been affiliated to Sri Venkateswara University, Tirupati ever since 1980.

The college is situated in a semi-urban area. Majority of student's hail from villages, whose parents are mostly illiterates and these students are first generation learners.

The meritorious students at the Intermediate level go for professional courses. Only the average, down-trodden and financially poor students seek admission into the degree courses here. Though their level of understanding is low, bridge courses, special coaching classes are conducted at the beginning of the academic year to raise such students to the required level of educational standards.

Despite, the existence of three private colleges in the town and the newly coming up colleges in the surrounding mandals, majority of students seek admission in this college

Apart from curricular aspects, much importance has always been given to the Co- curricular, extracurricular programmers, Culture and Extension Activities that go a long way in helping around development of the personality of the young learners, The college was Assessed and accredited by NAAC at the level of the B++ grade with 2.71 CGPA during 2013-14.

### **COLLEGE TIMINGS:**

### **ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

- A minimum of 75% attendance in each Semester is necessary to enable a student to write the university examination and to get Fee reimbursement in Jagananna Vidya Deevena Scheme.
- 2. Students who fall short of requisite attendance can seek condonation if they have put in at least 50% of the attendance and apply to the University through the Principal after payingthe prescribed fee. Students with less than 50% attendance will lose the academic year.
- It is compulsory for all students to enroll in "Jnanabhoomi Portal" to mark their attendance in the morning and evening daily.

### **CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)**

From 2015-16 CBCS was introduced for 1<sup>st</sup> year Degree students and now it covers all the three year courses with a common core syllabus and Academic schedule. In this, for every Six months students will write University Exam which is called "Semester Exam". In a year two semesters will be there. Before this Two Mid exams & One Pre-final will be there for which attendance is mandatory.
